

SUNY OSWEGO PHYSICS SCHOLARSHIP FRESHMAN PHYSICS MAJORS



\$1,000 each year for four years, resulting in a \$4,000 total scholarship.

This scholarship was established by Paul Vianco '80 to identify those high school students with a passion for physics and provide support for them as undergraduates in pursuit of a bachelor of science degree in physics at SUNY Oswego.

To qualify for this award, students must:

- > Be an incoming first-year student, pursuing a major in physics.
- > Have documented high school student involvement/leadership activities, especially related to physics.
- > Show academic promise in high school.
- > Be a student from the Central New York region (first preference).*

(Second preference: If five qualified incoming new students cannot be identified from the Central New York region wishing to major in physics, the preference will be expanded to consider any incoming new student from New York State majoring in physics.)

* The Central New York region is defined by these counties: Cayuga, Cortland, Madison, Onondaga and Oswego.
