- **Part III - Provide one letter of recommendation** attesting to your abilities as a student and good character that indicates you are prepared and ready for success when you attend and institution of higher learning.

**Directions:** Provide one letter of recommendation from a person (not a family member) attesting to your abilities as a student, that you are of good character, and that indicates you have skills and abilities that have prepared you and made you ready for success when you attend an institution of higher learning.
